Science and Geography

The last two weeks of school we have already learned a lot! We have been talking about our body parts; our head, feet, legs, hands, arms, brain, bones, our respiratory system, digestive system, and circulatory system. Practical Life and Sensorial

An activity we have been working on is Knobless cylinders; this activity helps visual discrimination of height and diameter. The Pink Tower was also introduced, this activity helps with fine motor skills and visual discrimination of three linear dimensions; length, height, and width. Some students have also worked with touch boards; this activity helps children become conscious of different textures.

Math and Language

Some children work with number rods, we have also worked with sandpaper numbers. Some children are also working on counting and writing numbers. Some children are also getting introduced to addition. Some children have worked with oval, circle, and triangle insets, this activity helps to prepare the children for printing, holding a pencil properly, and how to sit correctly when writing. Children have also been working with sandpaper letters. We have been working on sorting activities; for example we sorted healthy vs. non- healthy foods and vegetables vs. fruit. The children have been working with opposites and prepositions. We have also been talking about rhyming words.
